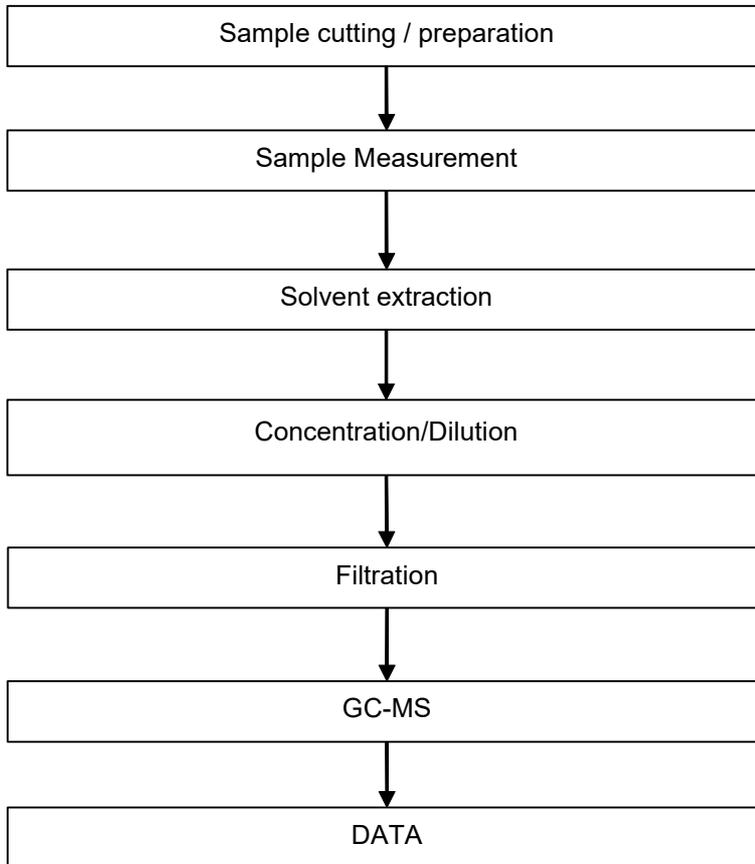


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Phthalates Testing Flow Chart

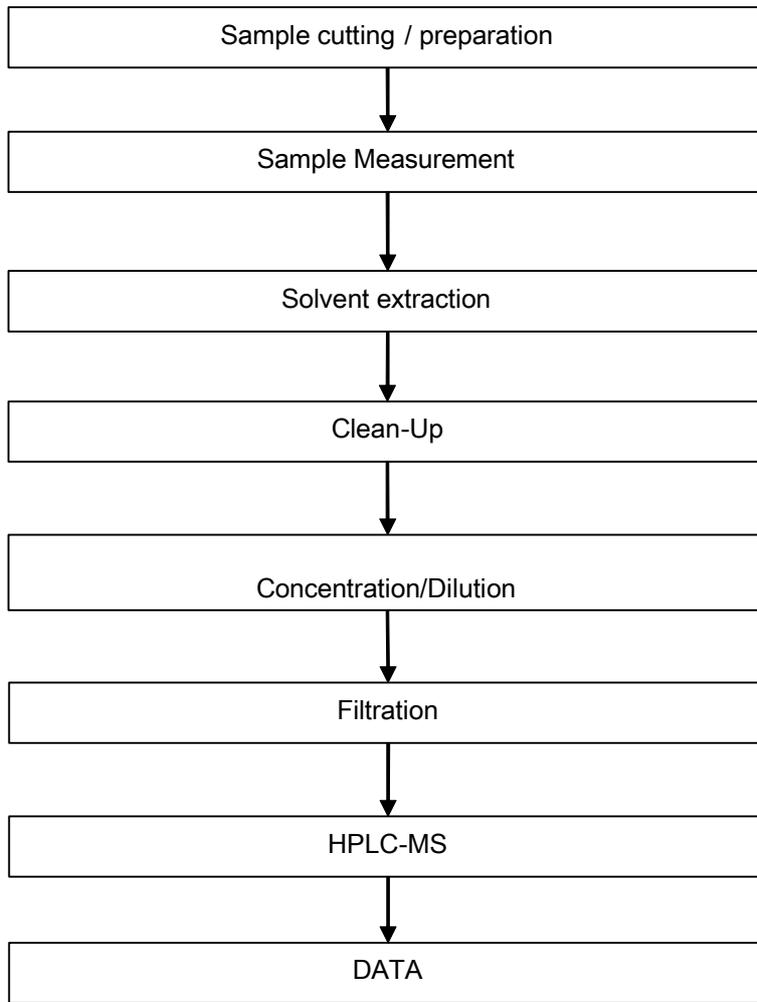


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BPA Testing Flow Chart

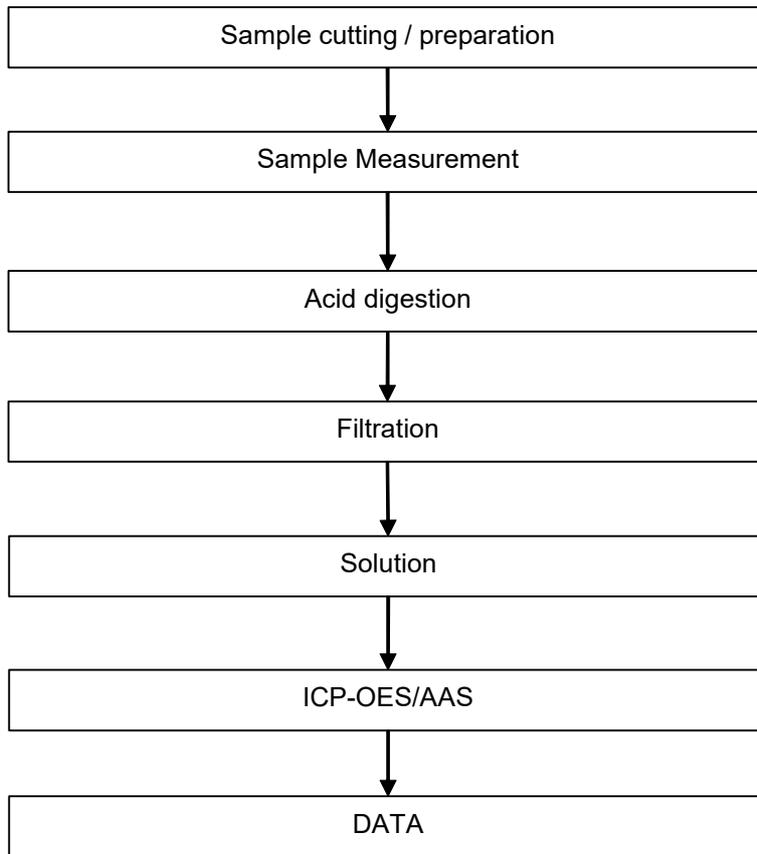


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Elementary Testing Flow Chart
